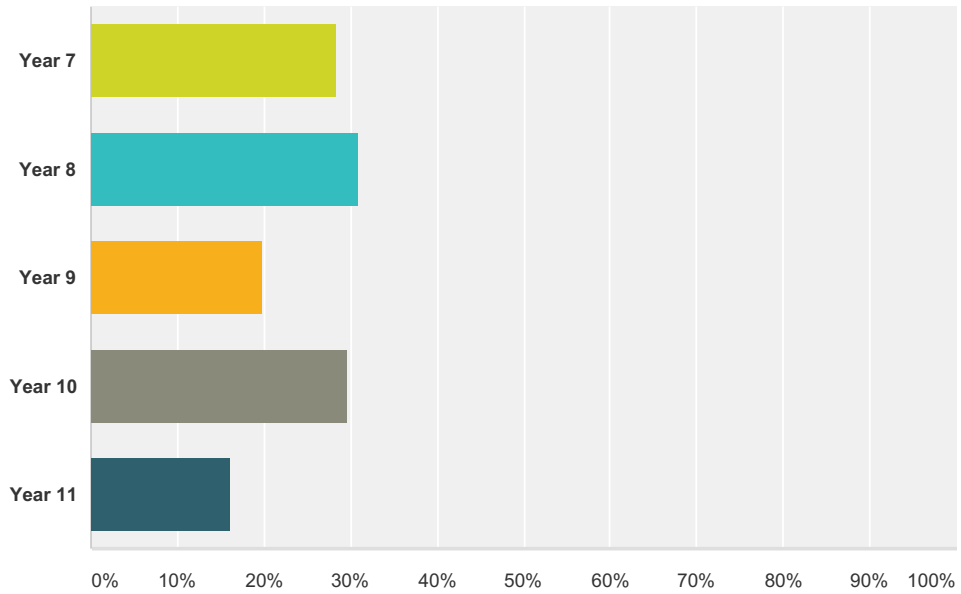


Q1 Which year groups in school do you currently have a child in? Please tick all that apply.

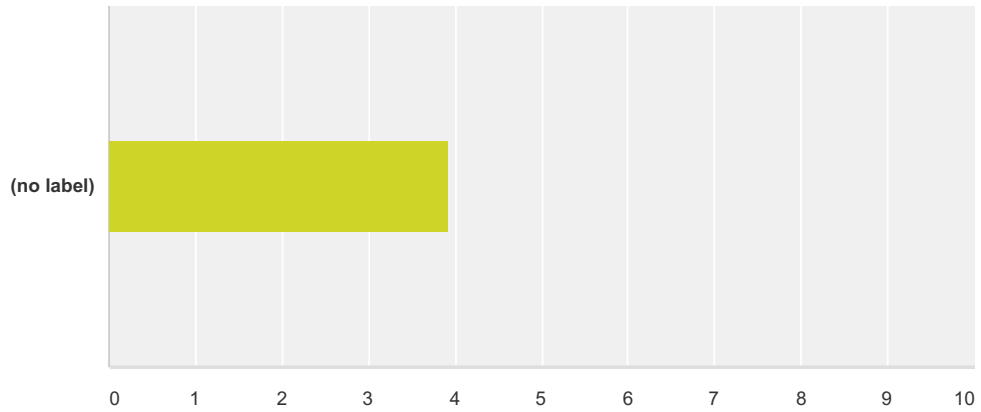

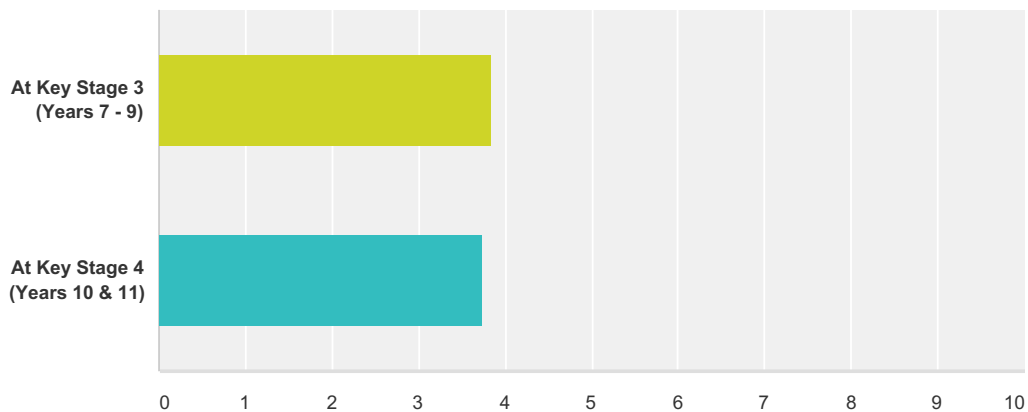

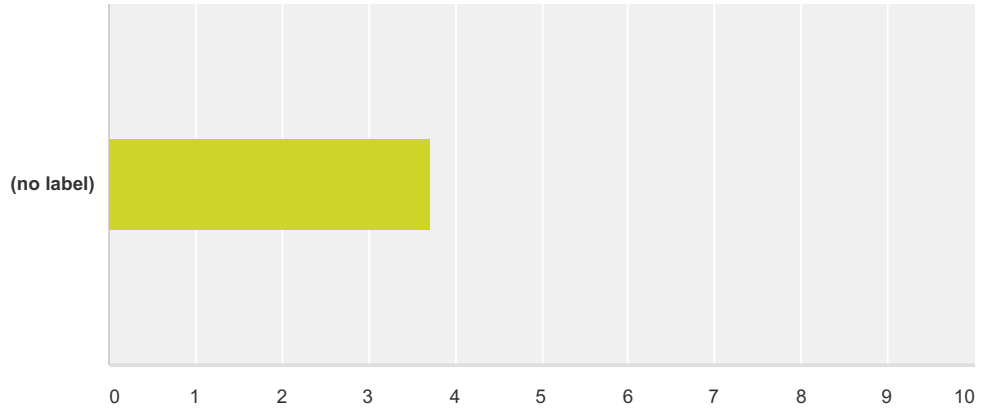

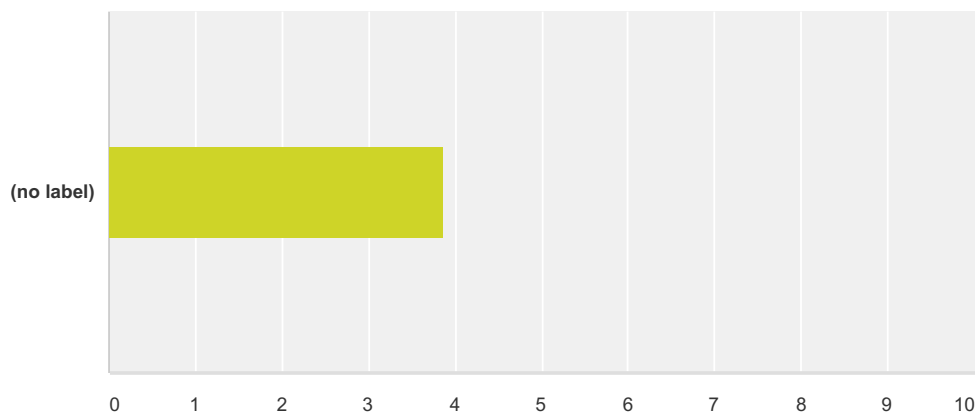

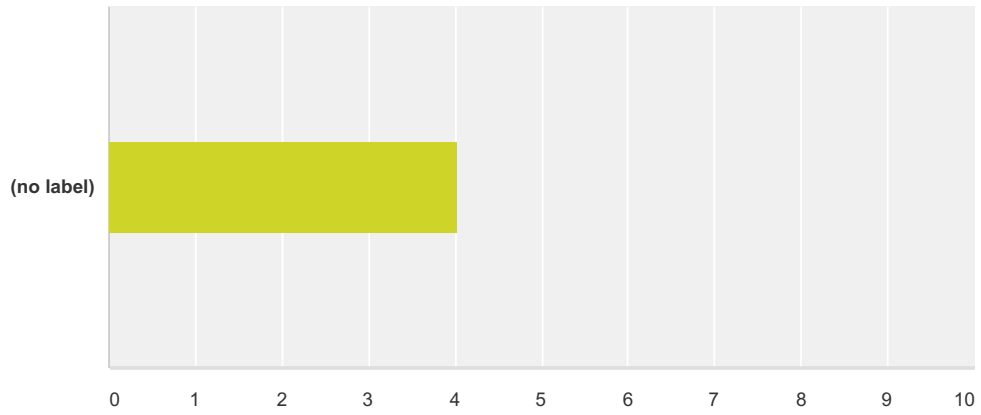

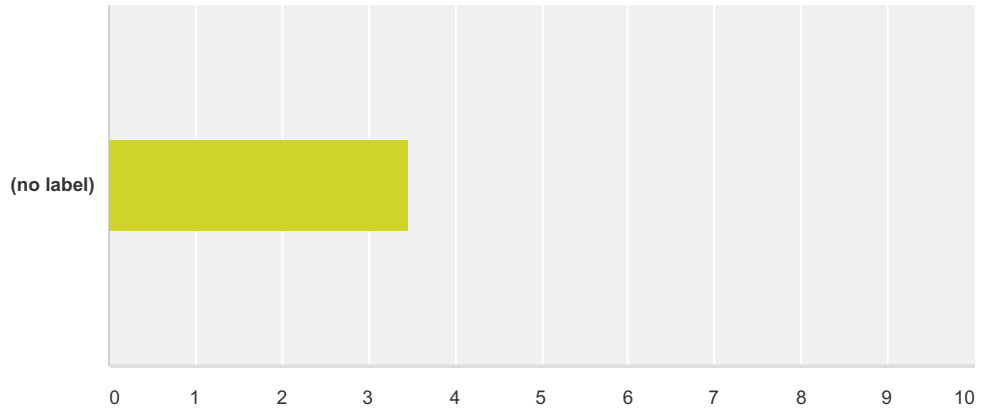

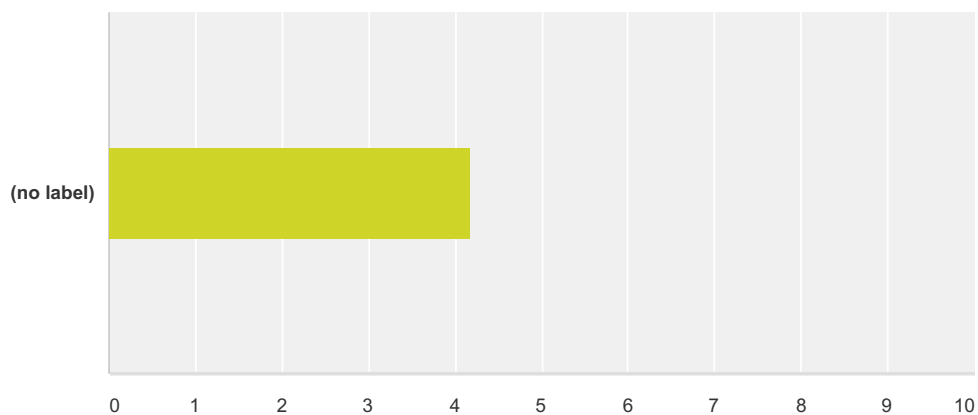

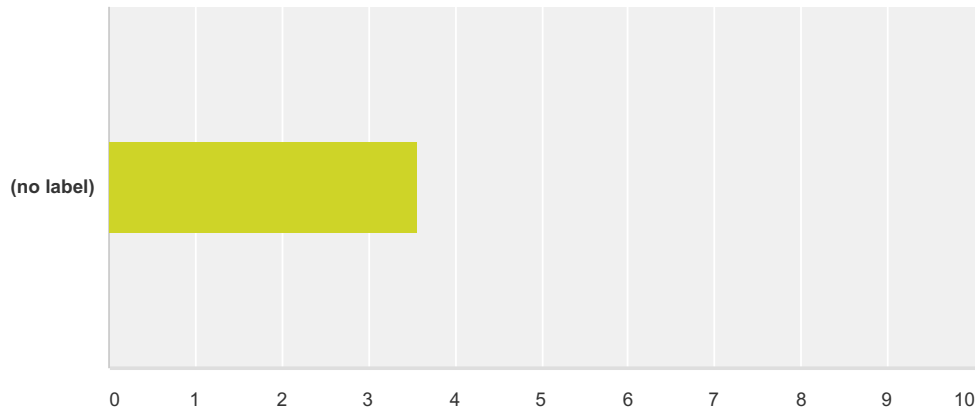

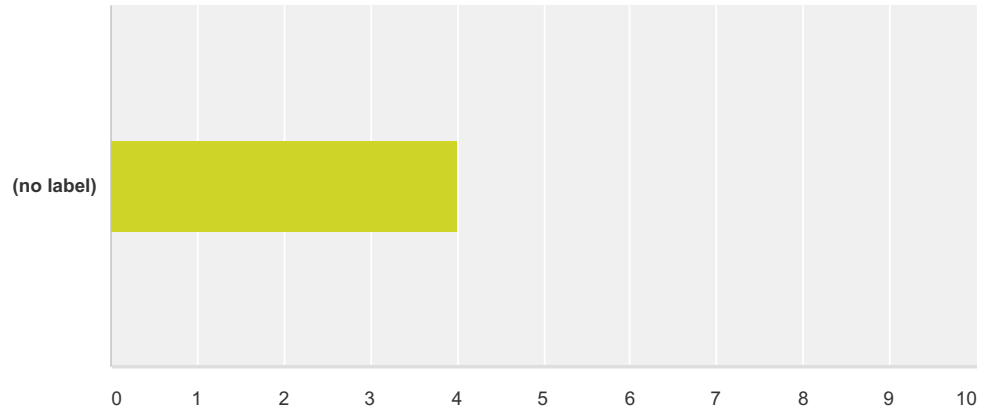
