The committee has responsibility delegated by the governing board for:

Achievement:

Undertake reviews to ensure that the **school:**

- Monitors and reviews information on school performance to include Analyse School Performance (ASP) & Ofsted Inspection Data Summary Report (IDSR).
- Monitors and sets school targets.
- Monitors and reviews in year progress for all year groups and all groups of pupils.
- Compares school performance against national data – see gov.uk for annual performance tables.
- Reports to parents according to statutory requirements.
- Monitors achievement for all and groups of pupils.
- Monitors pupils work and carry out pupil conversations.
- Monitors school target setting systems and how this is reported to parents.

Teaching & Learning:

- Reviews data published by DfE ensuring the school is meeting standards.
- Ensure targeted support and action plans are in place for all teachers who are not at least good.
- Ensure that staff training and CPD plans are in place and particularly in relation to Safeguarding and Safer Recruitment
- Ensure that the school:
 - Monitors and reviews the quality of teaching across the school.
 - Monitors teaching for all and groups of pupils.
 - Monitors impact of interventions for all groups of pupils.
 - Monitors homework arrangements.

Curriculum:

- Ensuring that the school:
 - Is meeting national curriculum requirements and to review the Curriculum Policy statement ensuring it meets the needs of all pupils including those with SEND.
 - Monitors and review the curriculum with a focus on basic skills.
 - Monitors the coverage of skills within the curriculum in all subjects.
- Receives information relating to parental engagement.
- Receive information relating to the SEF (Self Evaluation Form).
- Receive information on and reviews progress in relation to the School Improvement Plan.
- Monitors how the school are developing pupils' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development.
- Ensure the school has effective provision for SEND.

Behaviour & Attendance:

- Review Behaviour Policy, receive information about behaviour and monitor behaviour in school.
- Review and Monitor attendance data against school and national targets.

Welfare

- Ensure that relevant safeguarding procedures are in place and are effective in relation to child protection.
- To ensure that impartial careers advice is provided to pupils.
- Monitor pupils' attitudes, values and how other personal qualities are developed in the school.
